



Summer Nationals Super 64 13U & 14U Bracket

The Summer Nationals Super 64 echoes the College World Series regional format, designed to challenge and reward the strongest, most competitive 13u (60-90) and 14u teams in the nation. The test begins with 64 teams that are ranked and then placed into one of 16 regional brackets. Each group will play a 4-team double elimination format the first 2 days of the tournament.

From those games, 16 teams will be 0-2 (seeds 49-64) and over the next 3 days those teams will advance to the **“Back to the Beach Bracket”** where they will be placed into 4 pools of 4 according to seeding. Those teams will play 3 games in pool play; the top finisher from each pool advances into the single elimination **“Back to the Beach Bracket”** championship.

Also from the double elimination formats, 32 teams will have a record of 1-2, 2-2 or 3-2 and be seeded 17-48. Over the next 3 days, they will advance to the **“Pelican Bracket”** where they will be placed into 16 pools of 2 according to seeding and will cross-pool, playing 2 games. Out of that, the top 16 teams advance to the single elimination **“Pelican Championship Bracket”** (please note the first 4 eliminated from the Summer National Championship will drop into the Pelican Championship Bracket, which is a single-elimination championship of 20 teams).

The champions of each of the initial 16 double elimination brackets (seeds 1-16) over the next 3 days will advance to the “Summer National Championship Bracket” and compete in a double elimination bracket to determine the **Summer Nationals Super 64 Champion!** (Again, the first 4 eliminated from here drop into the Pelican Championship Bracket.)

It’s the most demanding tournament format in the country; can your team win eight games in five days to earn the honor of Summer Nationals champion?

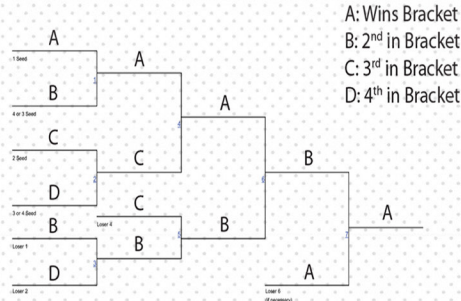

16 Four Team Double Elim Brackets



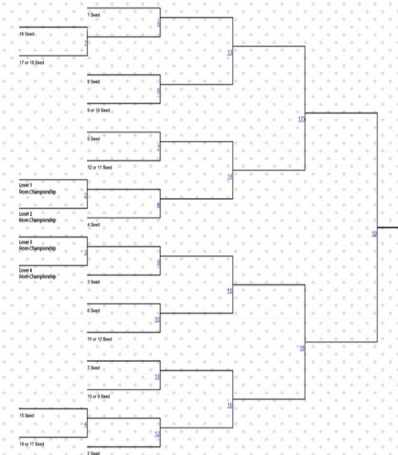
A Teams (16 Teams) Championship Bracket

Additional 2-8 Games



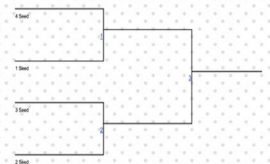
B and C Teams (32 Teams) Pelican Championship

Then 2 Games in Pool
(Teams are paired up based on Tiebreakers from previous games)
Top 16 Teams Advance to Single Elim Finish
PLUS the First 4 out of the Summer National Championship
Additional 2-4 Games



D Teams (16 Teams) Back To the Beach Bracket

All teams are 0-2
3 Games in Pool
(Teams are paired up based on Tiebreakers from previous 2 games)
Top 4 Teams Advance to Single Elim Finish
Additional 3-5 Games
